POLICY

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Revised policy

Uniform

As part of the Cedar International School identity, all students are required to adhere to the School Uniform Policy as set out below. Students who report to School inappropriately attired may be removed from class and their parents contacted. If available, they may be asked to wear a suitable item from the School supply.

Uniform Tops

Type: Short-sleeved polo shirt with embroidered Cedar logo
Colour: Evergreen or white
Suppliers: Lands' End, J&C Clothing or Cedar authorised supplier

Uniform Bottoms

Type (girls): Skorts, Chino-style Shorts, Chino-style Long Pants, A-line Skirts
Type (boys): Chino-style Shorts, Chino-style Long Pants
Colour: Khaki ONLY
Suppliers: Lands' End, or supplier of your choice*

Cargo pants, painters' pants, oversized pants and tight-fitting jeans-style are not acceptable.

All uniform bottoms must be worn at the waist and must not be shorter than mid-thigh.

Sweaters

Types: Plain or Solid Cardigan, Crewneck Sweater or Sweatshirt
Colour: Evergreen, white, khaki or tan
Suppliers: Land's End or supplier of your choosing*.

Socks:

Type: Plain evergreen, white, khaki or tan
Supplier: Lands' End or supplier of your choosing*.

PE. Uniform

Shirt: Plain white short-sleeve cotton t-shirt with logo:
Shorts: Khaki or tan shorts
Suppliers: Lands' End or supplier of your choosing*.

Closed in sneakers and socks must be worn during PE.

Footwear

All students are to wear closed in footwear. Sandals may be worn only if a child's foot is injured (to be indicated by a note from parents).

For safety concerns, heels higher than two inches must not be worn. No crocs or other similar footwear deemed inappropriate by the Director will be permitted.

Hats

Students in lower kinder through grade 5 are required to wear a hat that provides adequate sun protection on the playing field. Hats must not be worn in the building.

**NOTE: If you purchase items from alternate suppliers, the item MUST look like the Land's End equivalent in colour and style.*

Grade 12 Student Uniform Exception

Grade twelve students are exempt from the uniform requirements set out above, other than with respect to footwear, providing the following guidelines are adhered:

1. No spaghetti straps or tank tops;
2. No cut-off jeans;
3. Midriffs must be covered;
4. No see-through clothing;
5. No offensive logos or slogans; and
6. Skirt length must not be any shorter than mid-thigh.

Free Dress Days

Students shall be permitted to dress as they choose on the last Friday school day of every month providing the attire is clean, tidy and appropriate (as per grade 12 guidelines). Free dress days may be cancelled by the Director should they become disruptive.

Unless instructed otherwise, School uniforms should be worn on all School trips.
