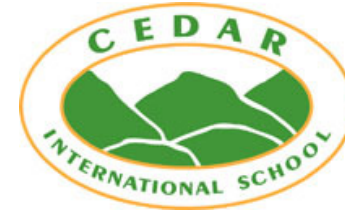

## Programme rules

In order for your child(ren) to participate in the clubs, we require the following to be returned to the front office:

**\* A completed and signed Registration Form and Parent/Student Release form.**

**\* Full payment for the club(s).**

In order to ensure the smooth and safe running of the clubs we ask that the following rules be noted:

- i) Generally clubs run from 3.15 till 4.15, unless otherwise indicated. If for any reason a club is cancelled (weather etc), every effort will be made to contact parents to notify them of the cancellation.
- ii) Parents will need to arrange transportation for clubs that occur off campus. **Please remember to collect your child(ren) on time.**
- iii) Most clubs will only run if a specific minimum number of students enroll.
- iv) Children should be collected promptly once the club ends. If you are unable to collect your child, he/she/they will be kept safe and placed in our after school care programme for which there will be a charge. Please note this service is not available for any club that ends after 5.30 pm on a weekday or at any time on the weekend.
- v) Cedar clubs are very popular and spaces are limited. To ensure your child has a space, payment must be received promptly.
- vi) All clubs operate on first come, first served basis.
- vii) In most cases, the price of the club assumes 1-2 sessions will be cancelled as a result of inclement weather or teacher commitments.
- viii) Please note that when participating in the clubs programme, students must adhere to the school code of behaviour at all times. Failure to comply may jeopardize their position in the club.
